

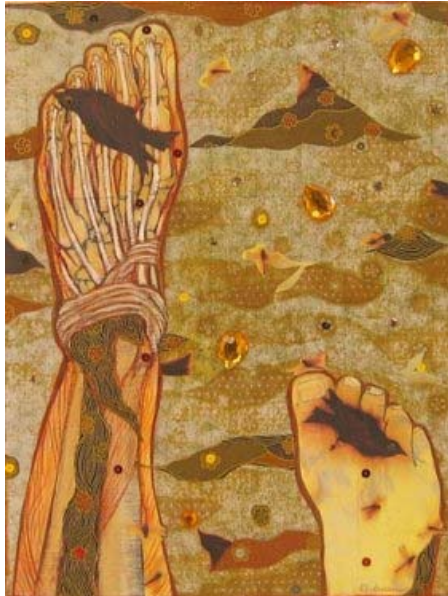

Concurrent with the 'Signatures of Age' Group Show at Woman Made Gallery is a solo exhibition with mixed media works by California artist, Helen Redman.

As she confronts and befriends her aging identity, she helps others to do so, no matter their age.
