CHICAGO—Woman Made Gallery (WMG) is proud to present "Indrani Nayar-Gall and Madelyn Turner: A Two-



Woman Show," on view from June 17 to July 8, 2023. Juror Ashley Wynn selected the two artists based on their artworks in WMG's 2022 Feminist Biennial. The exhibition brings together paintings, installations, and videos that make visible trauma, grief, and rage as a response to life in a patriarchal world.

A multidisciplinary feminist artist, **Indrani Nayar-Gall** weaves global narratives of marginalization, patriarchy, and misogyny

through her practice in installations involving 2-D and 3-D media. Social

justice themes stem from influences in her mixed north-south Indian background, parental modeling of community engagement and helping marginalized women in need, the mentorship of socially engaged professors, and socio-political activism. Indrani has exhibited nationally and internationally. She founded Yes She Rises LLC, a campaign to empower sex workers in India.

In her work, **Madelyn Turner** wrestles with society's idealized construction of the feminine form and its relationship to her own body. A figurative painter based in Illinois, Madelyn has a BA in studio art and is currently pursuing an MFA degree at Illinois State University. She is interested in the space between figuration and abstraction, including how



this exploration can create a new way of exploring her body and experiences with the societal consciousness of feminine identity.
