My work got selected in several of their shows after that. For the Deeply Rooted, the juror was so moved by my work, she wanted to include me in the panel discussion with artists from different diasporas and that conversation was incredibly touching!!

This year my work was chosen for the 24th International Open, won the secondplace award and again featured on the banner and it was heartening to see pictures of visitors posing with the installation, Diaphanous Illusions. The growing installation is currently part of the World of Threads Festival at Oakville, Canada. And it has grown some more since it was installed at WMG!!
